Day 01 _____ / BANGKOK (Dinner)

Upon arrival at Suvarnabhumi Airport and after clearing customs, please proceed to the Meeting Point area at Exit B (Gate 06) of the arrival hall on Level 2. For passengers arriving at Don Muang Airport, please proceed to Door 2 at the Arrival Hall. Our local representative will be there to welcome and thereafter, proceed to explore Chocolate Ville - a popular restaurant that is designed to resemble a small quaint European Village, complete with a chapel, barn, clock tower, railway station as well as candy-coloured shops; and features "Dining in the Park" experience; OR The Rome Restaurant - a mammoth of an al fresco dining area with imposing Roman statues as well as posh seating areas located in middle of a spacious pool. << For passengers with halal meal arrangements requests, Chocolate Ville OR The Rome Restaurant is arranged as a photo stop only >> After dinner, relax and unwind with Nanta Cooking Show - an action packed non-verbal theatrical performance with thrilling percussion music that is created using everything from traditional Korean water drums to cooking utensils such as whisks and carving knives. Its non-stop rhythmic percussion is complemented by hilarious facial expressions plus a little help from the audience to create a humorous story of a hapless gang of chefs. Alternatively, indulge in a complimentary 01-hour Thai Massage.

Day 02 BANGKOK / HUA HIN (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, journey approximately 230 kilometres Southwest of Bangkok to Hua Hin, Thailand's Royal Beach Resort; with enroute stops along the way, starting with a visit to Swiss Sheep Farm that features both natural beauty as well as scenic landscape á la Switzerland. Experience being a shepherd, bottle-feed a calf, pet or take pictures with the sheep; enjoy riding a pony; take part in fun yet romantic activities where couples can help each other to hang a key of love as a symbol of everlasting relationship; etc... << some activities at Swiss Sheep Farm are optional, at own expense >> Thereafter, continue on to explore a slice of picture-perfect Greek Island at Santorini Park - an amusement theme park with boutique-style shopping in an array of nicely presented whitewashed buildings, colourfully painted windows, stone-paved paths as well as domed towers inspired by the picturesque Greek Island. << rides and activities at Santorini Park are optional, at own expense >>. Upon your arrival at Hua Hin, visit PlearnWan - a vintage village containing two-storey wooden complexes of stylized old-fashioned shop houses, a reminiscent of those that once made up the Thai-Chinese neighbourhoods of Bangkok and Hua Hin. Wander around the classic charms of old Hua Hin and enjoy a little shopping for some local delicacies, vintage merchandise, retro souvenirs, etc...; followed by a dose charming and romantic ambience of The Venezia - a unique lifestyle shopping destination with over 360 stores offering a variety of fashion and accessories as well as trendy restaurants and pubs. This 73,600m² Venice-inspired theme shopping and attraction village also feature replicas of Venice's most symbolic landmarks such as The Bell Tower of San Marco, Piazza San Marco, Trevi Fountain as well as a 200-meter Grand Canal with the iconic Gondola ride that navigates around the village. In the evening, enjoy a stroll around Hua Hin Night market for a fascinating insight into the local people's lifestyle where one can find countless stalls selling freshly cooked local delicacies as well as an overwhelming variety of local handicrafts, souvenirs as well as clothing.

Day 03 HUA HIN / AMPHAWA / BANGKOK (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, start the day with a sightseeing tour around the city visiting Hua Hin Railway Station - one of Thailand's oldest railway stations with a long cultural heritage and unique architecture. The splendid Royal Waiting Room used to be a royal pavilion at Sanam Chan Palace during the reign of King Rama IV which was relocated and rebuilt at Hua Hin Railway Station in 1968. Thereafter, visit Wat Huay Mongkol - home to the famous Giant Luang Phor Thuad statue, a Buddhist monk famed for his "miracles" and lived some 400 years ago; before embarking on your return journey back to Bangkok. Along the way, take a breather to explore the picturesque Maruekhathaiyawan (Mrigadayavan) Palace. Often referred to as "The Palace of Love and Hope", this Thai-Victorian summer seaside getaway was constructed in the early 1920s during the reign of King Rama VI using golden teak from the demolished Hat Chao Samran Palace. Set on a vast manicured landscape and fronting the idyllic Cha Am Beach, this candy-coloured mansion comprises three one-storey pavilions with lots of verandas, latticework and high ceilings as well as covered boardwalk, on more than 1,000 raised pillars. At the next stop, wander around the array of stalls and walkways along the bustling canal of Amphawa Floating Market which was revived from an old market where fruit and vegetable growers used to trade their produce 50 years ago. As the sun goes down and darkness falls, see thousands of tiny lightning bugs (subject to weather conditions) flickering and sparkling along the riverbanks and partying among the mangrove trees, creating a very romantic ambience.



Day 04 BANGKOK (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, proceed on your selected sightseeing tour, choice of ONE - either Bangkok Sightseeing & Shopping Tour OR Dinosaur Planet & Shopping Tour.

Bangkok Sightseeing & Shopping Tour :

Start with a visit to Wat Pho - one of the largest and oldest temple complexes in the city and is home to more than 1,000 Buddha images. Famed for its giant reclining Buddha measuring 15 metres high and 46 metres long, the temple was the first public university in Thailand that specialises in Religion, Science as well as Literature but it now an important centre for traditional medicine, notably Thai massage. Thereafter, continue on to the west bank of the Chao Phraya River to visit the famous Wat Arun (temple admission is optional, on own expense). Better known as the Temple of Dawn, it has an imposing spire (Prang) of over 70 meters high, beautifully decorated with tiny pieces of coloured glass and chinese porcelain placed delicately into intricate patterns.

Dinosaur Planet & Shopping Tour :

Explore the 15,000 m² prehistoric world of Dinosaur Planet - a complete edutainment centre that will take you back in time to the ancient world of dinosaurs where visitors can get to know the various types of dinosaurs; explore the bottom of the ocean and brave the adrenaline pumping Raptor X-Treme; as well as enjoy memorable activities and world-class performances. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at EmQuartier - a lifestyle mall that is home to a whopping 400 labels covering a total of over 4,000 square metres of floor space.

Thereafter, visit Bangkok Gems Gallery - the world's biggest jewellery store to see the vast selection of gems and jewellery while enjoying complimentary refreshment; Bangkok's Finest Genuine Leather Shop where you will learn how to tell the difference between real and fake leather; as well as a local bee farm which offers a wide selection of natural honey products. Later in the evening, visit Asiatique The Riverfront - Bangkok's first large-scale riverside project combining shopping, dining, sightseeing, activities as well as events under one roof.

Day 05 BANGKOK / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, if time permits, visit Erawan Shrine that houses the famous Four-Faced Phra Phrom - Thai's representation of the Hindu God Lord Brahma; and thereafter, enjoy some last-minute shopping at Platinum Fashion Mall - an indoor version of the Chatuchak Weekend Market that specializes in wholesale clothing as well as accessories; until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
